1.	The pre-bid meeting for PACKAGE-7: "CONSTRUCTION OF BOUNDARY WALL AND ALLIED FACILITIES AT DEPOT II" was held with the SMTA (Client), Consultant (DAR & NESPAK JV) and prospective bidders to present the overall project and answer bidders' questions.

The queries raised along with the responses of the Client/Consultant are given below: Query No. 1: What is the cutoff time for the submission of bid queries? Response: The queries can be submitted no later than 7 days before the bid submission date of August 10, 2022. Query No. 2: Are there any additional requirements or documents required for the proposal? Response: All the documents required are mentioned in the bidding documents and must be submitted along with the bid proposal in compliance with the requirements of the bidding documents (bidding forms).

	Query No. 3: Is the requirement of an HSE expert mandatory?
	Response: As the project is funded by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), strict compliance to the HSE will be followed and all the requirements as mentioned in the bidding documents are mandatory.
